June 17 **Churchill Downs Night Racing** **meet in the Paddock area near the Aristides statue**

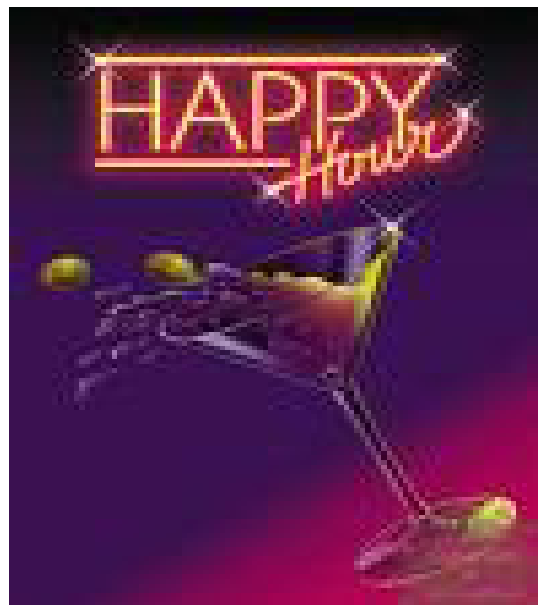
This will be our last chance this Summer to enjoy night racing at Churchill Downs
