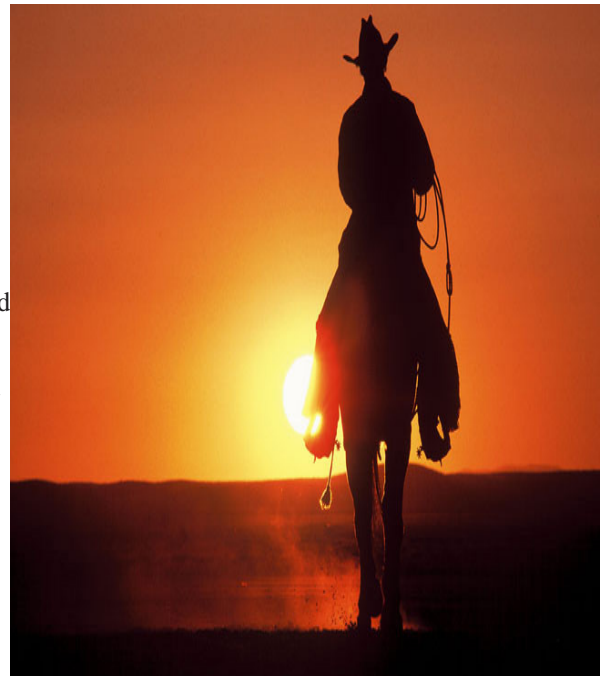
One of us can help you with the how and whys of the paperwork that we do.

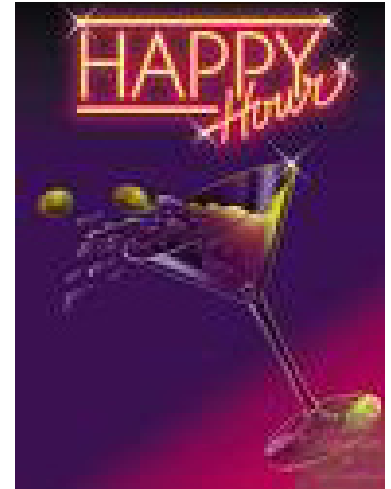
