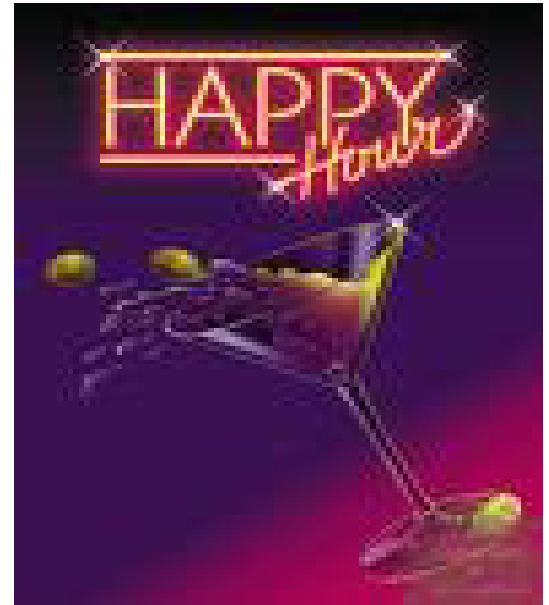

I hear it is the current 'hot' spot.

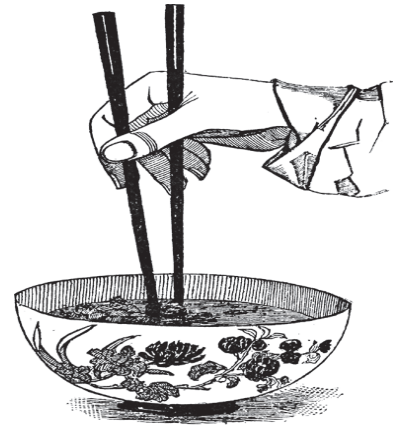
